17th – 21st October 2022

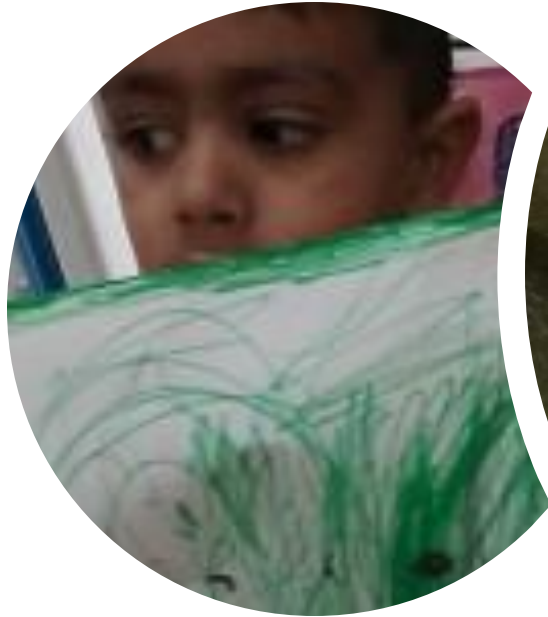


In Nursery and Reception, we have been using this opportunity to find out more about our world and to celebrate the many nationalities and cultures represented in our school.

We thought about the values of respect, responsibility, equality, fairness and consideration.

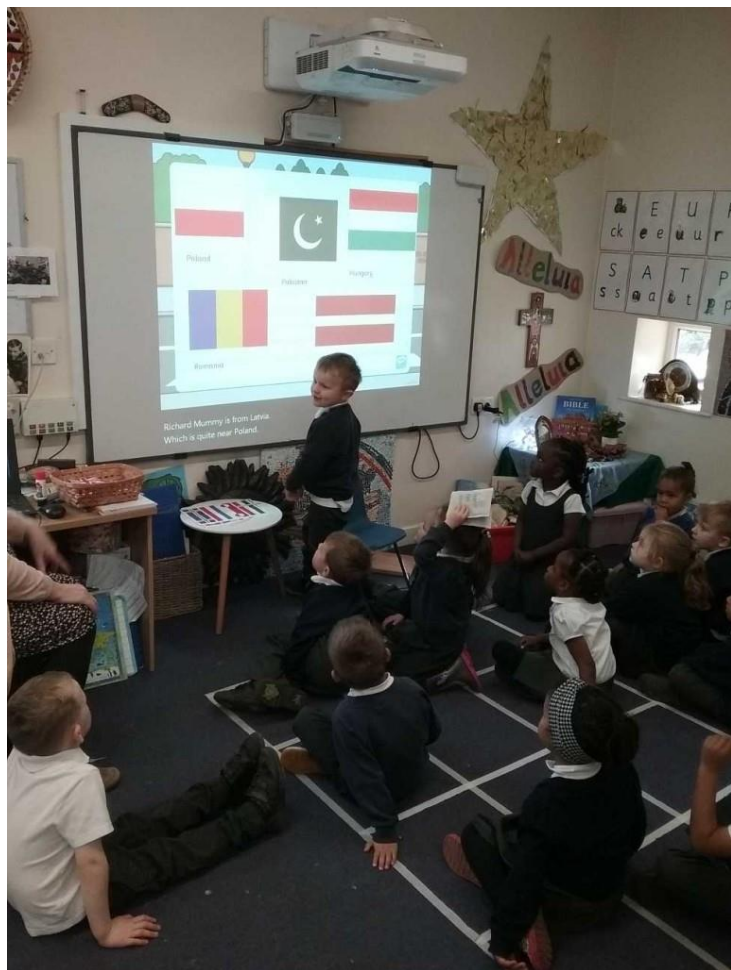
